2011 WSBS Competition Awards List

Here is the list of awards for our 2011 state show in Madison. When you put your tray together, keep a few general guidelines in mind: Use the 2011/2012 edition of the NBS Classification Guidelines (the blue book) as you work on your trays. Labeling isn't required for most awards, but if you want to get the most points for your efforts, labeling will direct judges' attention to things they might otherwise miss. Don't worry if you goof on a label when labeling isn't required, it won't hurt you. Remember the 20% guideline. You'll find it on page 7 of the blue book under "What is the TWENTY PERCENT GUIDELINE (overloading)?" If there are exceptions to the 20% rule, they are written into the award as a specialization or as a limit of (or no limit on) phrase.

DIVISION I

- 1. Div I Class 6-4.3 Small Black Glass with paint, enamel. \$5-3-2
- 2. Div I Class 11-0 20 Any Shell specialized to pictorials. \$5-3-2
- 3. Div I Class 17-0 through 20-24 Small Specialized to Black Glass. Best representation of all four sections. \$5-3-2

DIVISION III

- 4. Div III Class 7-0 Med-Large Clear and Colored Glass Assorted. Label with class number and/or class name. Mount in numerical order. \$10-6-4
- 5. Div III Class 12-1.3 20 Any Specialized to Phenolic resin (Bakelite, Catalin, etc.) In memory of Clyde Anderson. \$10-6-4

DIVISION IV

6. Div IV Class 6-2 12 pair of links depicting plants and/or animals. No balance required. \$5-3-2

DIVISION VII-A Juniors ages 6 through 12

7. Div VII-A Class 17-0 through 20-24 10 Any Choose a favorite book. Mount 10 buttons that represent things in the book. Label each button as to what it represents. Look for a variety of things from the book (not just the characters). Include buttons of various sizes, materials, colors, etc. Write a paragraph summary about the book for the judges. Have fun and be creative! \$5-3-2

DIVISION VII-B Juniors ages 13 through 17

8. Div VII-B Class 17-0 through 20-24 10 Any Choose a favorite book. Mount 10 buttons that represent things in the book. Label each button as to what it represents. Look for a variety of things from the book (not just the characters). Include buttons of various sizes, materials, colors, etc. Write a paragraph summary about the book for the judges. Have fun and be creative! \$5-3-2

DIVISION IX

- 9. Div IX Class 1-0 Various Celluloid assorted. \$5-3-2
- 10. Div IX Class 1-0 through 15-5 Various Specialized to buttons in shades of purple. The buttons need not be all purple but should have a significant amount of purple. \$5-3-2
- 11. Div IX Class 3-0 Small China assorted. Try for a wide array of colors. \$10-7-3

- 12. Div IX Class 8-3 and 23-9 20 Any Specialized to drums, including those with glass centers and those with centers of other materials. No balance necessary. \$10-6-4
- 13. Div IX Class 10-0 Small Metal assorted specialized to pictorial. May have DF and OME. \$5-3-2
- 14. Div IX Class 10-0 Various Metals Assorted. Labeling helpful but not required. WSBS Trophy Award: Free one-year membership to WSBS for each club member who works on the winning tray. Winning club will hold the trophy until Summer 2012.
- 15. Div IX Class 11-9 18 Any Shell, specialized to working methods. Include six examples for each of the three subclasses of 11-9. (Buttons can show more than one working method.) \$10-6-4
- 16. Div IX Class 13-0 Mixed Vegetable Ivory assorted. \$5-3-2
- 17. Div IX Class 17-0 through 20-24 15 Any Specialized to objects found under the water. To be mounted on a creative mounting. Winner to be determined by vote. No limit on realistics or studios. Special prize to the winner.
- 18. Div IX Class 17-4.3 and 17-4.3.1 25 Any Specialized to insects, butterflies and moths. No balance necessary. \$5-3-2
- 19. Div IX Class 17-0 through 20-24 20 Any Pictorial subjects beginning with the letter "M" or "W" in honor of the 2011 State show location in Madison, Wisconsin. No balance between classes necessary. \$5-3-2
- 20. Div IX Class 18-5 25 Any Claws, feet, hands, hoofs, paws. \$7-5-3
- 21. Div IX Class 18-6.1 25 Any Buttons depicting belts and/or buckles. \$5-3-2
- 22. Div IX Class 18-6.3 20 Any Footwear and people wearing footwear. Limit 2 studios. \$5-3-2
- 23. Div IX Class 20-24 15 Any Specialized to buttons depicting science fiction. No limit on realistic or studio buttons. \$5-3-2
- 24. Div IX Class 23-3.3.1 25 Any Whistles. Must include large, medium and small. No Balance necessary. \$5-3-2
- 25. Div IX Class 23-10.3 20 Any Realistic buttons; specialized to buttons depicting book titles. Label each button with book title and author. Example: A brown fox button labeled "Brown Fox Mystery by Ellery Queen"; or a strawberry button labeled "Strawberry Girl by Lois Lenski". \$5-3-2
- 26. Div IX Class 25-5.2.2.1 (corresponds to Sect. 17) 25 Any Livery crests depicting animals. Include at least 5 NBS small buttons \$10-7-3
